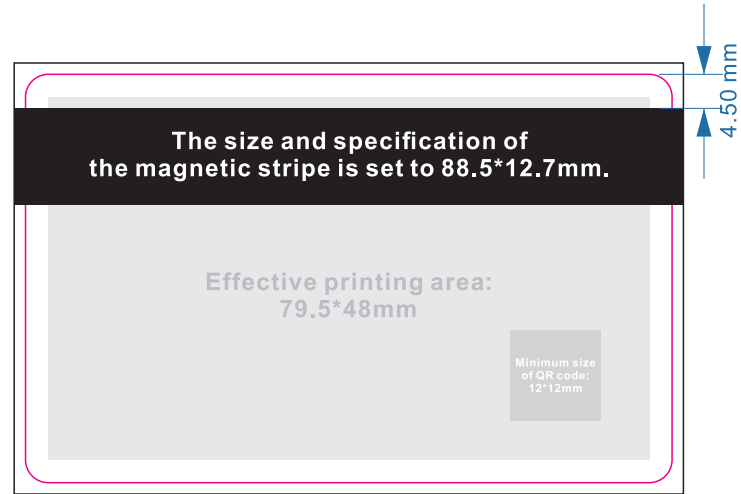
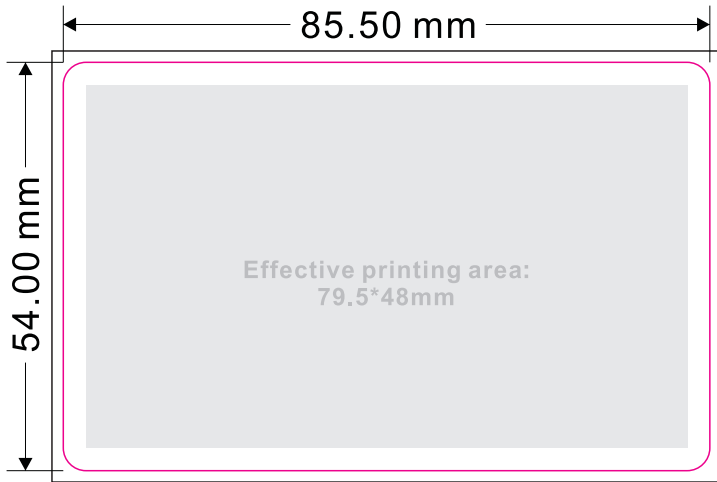
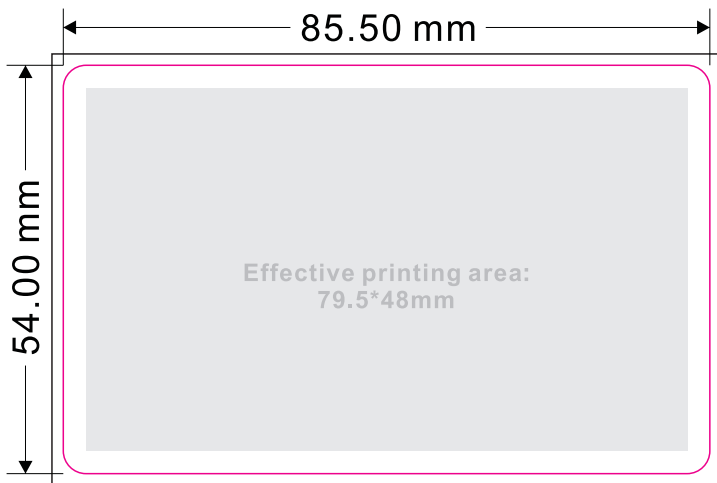

The barcode location needs to be designed with white color blocks to facilitate barcode recognition in the later stage. The barcode types are divided into 128A code (with letters, which can be scanned out), 128C code (only numbers can be scanned out), 39 code (with dense barcode lines and a larger area), and 13 code (requiring 13 digits, consisting of 12 fixed digits plus a random code at the end, with the first digit of the number not being 0). Barcodes can be made using ordinary inkjet printing and UV inkjet printing. Note that UV inkjet printed barcodes cannot be made together with irreversible processes such as embossed codes and laser codes.
