

BEFORE YOU BEGIN:

- Read this entire installation guide.
- Make sure that your boat deck is dry and clean and free of any debris or obstacles.
- Gather Your Supplies: **Clear Plastic Film, Masking Tape, Sharpie Pen, Scissors**

START TEMPLATING:

1. Cover The Area

- Lay the plastic sheet flat over the area you want to cover. If the area is too large to be covered , carefully tape two pieces together and add "match" lines so we can join these together accurately.
- Use masking tape to secure it firmly at the edges, preventing it from shifting while you work.

Tip: Work on one section at a time for the best accuracy.





3. Draw The Template

Begin tracing out the objects on the deck and outlining the perimeter of the deck.

Make thin, strong lines so we can tell exactly where you want the edge of your decking to be.



Using a straight edge or a carpenters' square can help in straight areas.

Your deck will be built to the exact lines that you provide for us. Do not leave sections unfinished.




4. Label The Template

- label the template pieces/sections with the corresponding locations of your boat (bow, stern, helm, swim platform, port, starboard, cooler, etc.)
- if you want us to add a logo or some type of customization, please be sure to label that location as well.



5. Take Pictures

- be sure to take pictures before you remove the template from your boat, the more pictures the better! We can then use the pictures to help understand your boat and help answer any questions we might have.



6. Remove The Template

- gently remove the template, being sure not to rip it or smudge the markings.
- fold it up and prepare it for shipping.
